We have continued learning about decimals in maths this week - with children comparing and ordering decimals by value.

In English, children identified key features of a non-chronological report and researched facts about tigers. They then organised their research into paragraphs and wrote a non-chronological report on tigers, inspired by the tiger from Cinnamon.

In computing this week, children learned how to use several tools to select, copy and paste. They then implemented this learning into combining images to create their own unique image.

Swimming lessons are always a highlight of the week and this week the focus was learning and practicing breast stroke.

Children continued to make their aprons in DT - using running stitch to attach their straps to the main body.
