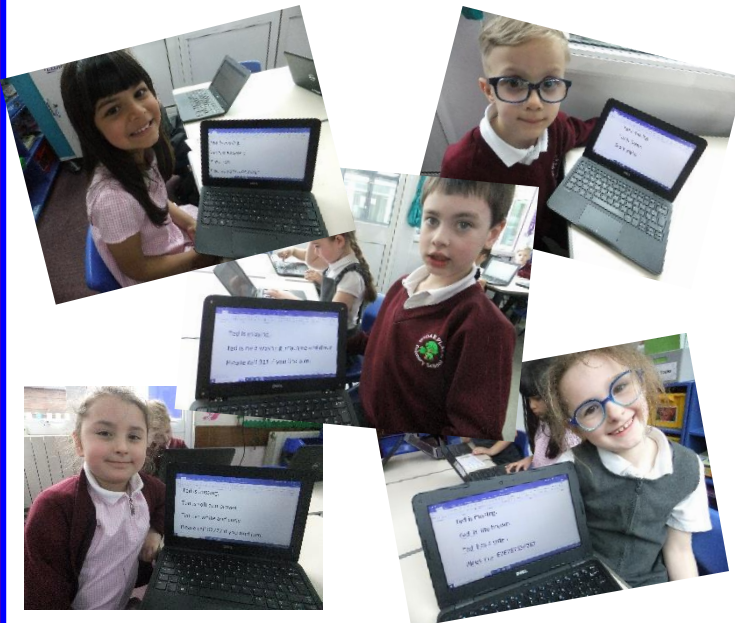

In English, we have continued to read *The Naughty Bus*. The children have really enjoyed thinking of new adventures for the Naughty Bus and have been writing their own stories, using adjectives to make them more interesting.

In Computing, we have been using Microsoft Word. The children started by exploring the keyboard, identifying and locating different keys, and then moved on to adding text to a Word document using a range of key functions.
