Year 3 trip to Haslemere Museum

The children had a wonderful opportunity to reinforce and extend their learning about Ancient Egypt. Throughout the day, the children took an active part in vibrant discussions, confidently sharing their existing knowledge while also developing their understanding through new experiences. They showed great enthusiasm during the mummification workshop, eagerly contributing ideas and demonstrating what they had learnt in class about the mummification process.

The children also explored the museum exhibits, carefully observing a range of Ancient Egyptian artefacts and discussing their purpose and significance. To end the day, the children thoroughly enjoyed mummifying their own toy, an activity which sparked excellent discussions, creativity, and a strong focus on using hieroglyphics. The trip was an engaging and memorable experience that brought their history learning to life.

Food Vouchers

Surrey County Council have confirmed they will be providing Free School Meal Holiday Vouchers to cover the May 2026 half term holiday to those children who are eligible for free school meals. This support will be funded through the new UK Government funded Crisis and Resilience Fund with supermarket food vouchers to the value of £10 per child for the whole May half-term holiday period 2026.
