

Year 2 Learning Letter

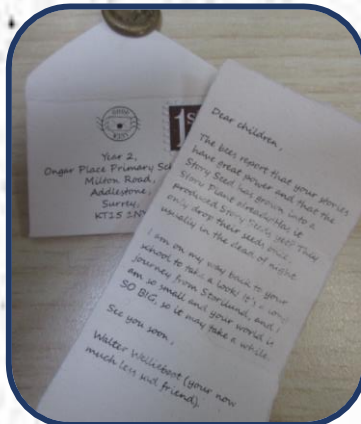
Friday 15th May 2026
