We have finished our maths unit on money this week. Children learnt how to calculate and problem solve using money before completing their end of unit quiz. In English, children sequenced the key events in Harvey Milk's life and wrote these into a short paragraph using adverbials.

In Geography this week, children matched climate descriptions with climate graphs and had a go at creating their own climate graph for Addlestone using data provided.
