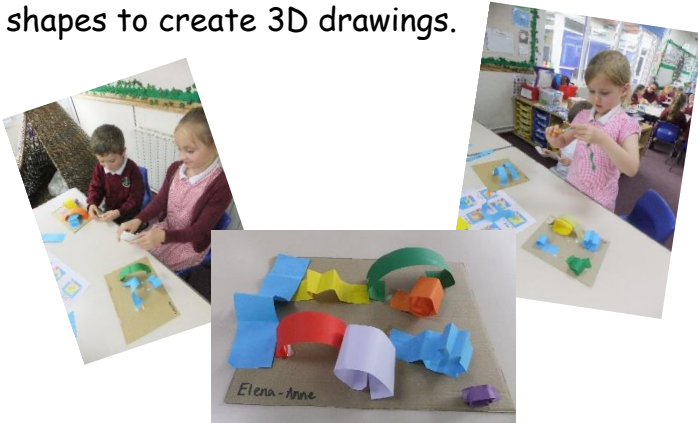

Learning Journey

This half term in Computing, we have started using the programming app, Scratch Jr., on iPads. The children explored the 'move' blocks to program a cat sprite and loved watching it follow their instructions across the screen.

Our focus in Art this term is 3D sculptures. The children explored creating three-dimensional artwork by folding and rolling strips of coloured paper, then arranging the shapes to create 3D drawings.



In Topic this week we have been learning about the Blitz. We talked about what the Blitz was, what the people and children did during the war and how London had to rebuild itself again. We then looked at artefacts from World War 2 which we borrowed from Chertsey museum.
