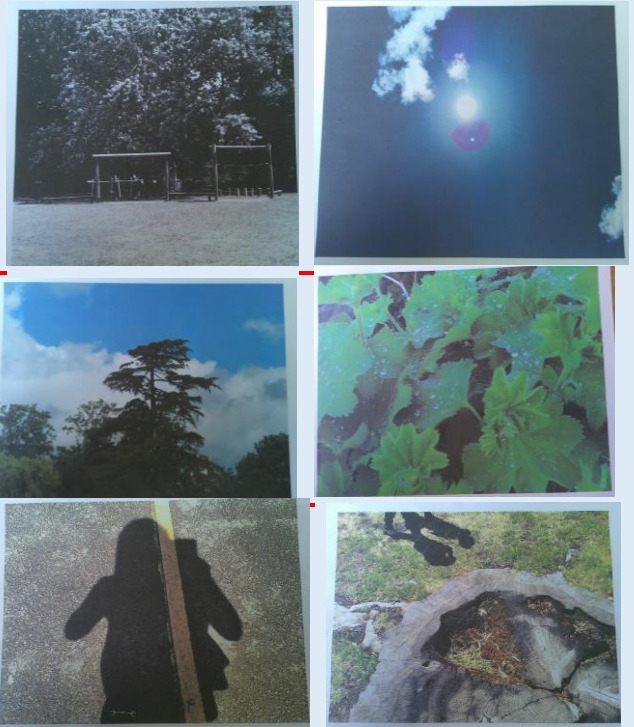


Week 7 Summer Term
