We had such a fantastic day out at Wisley Gardens on Tuesday. It was great to see the children so captivated by the tropical plants and leaves they saw in the Glasshouse, which has helped inspire their creativity when creating all our wonderful Rainforest artwork as part of the Delight programme.

In English this week, children wrote a recount of their school trip, focusing on the key events and reflecting on their favourite parts of the day.

In maths, children learnt about triangles, quadrilaterals and polygons - recognising the features of each of these.

In Geography this week, we looked at the Amazon Rainforest and learnt why it is so hot and wet. Children learnt about the vast river network of the River Amazon and how convection currents play their part in the regular, heavy rainfall experienced in this region.

In computing, children animated their name/initials in Scratch. They chose their letter designs and decided how they wanted them to move. They planned their design and then followed their plan in the program.

Science saw us learning about vertebrates and invertebrates. They learnt a vertebrate is an animal with a spine, and they learnt which groups of animals are vertebrates.
