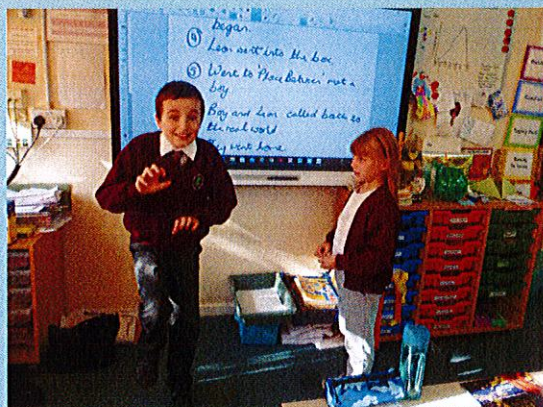
In science we have been learning about the life cycle of plants. Here we are playing a physical game to help us learn what plants need to stay alive.



In PE, we have learnt some football skills such as passing and dribbling. We have also learnt lots of different dances from around the world. Here we are giving 'Bollywood' dancing a try.



On European Day of Languages, we sang German folk songs, tasted German bread, sausage and cheese and made Bavarian hats. We also learnt the colours in German and how to say a few useful phrases.



After half term we will be focusing on multiplication. Please ask your children to revise their 2, 5 and 10 times tables, and begin to learn their threes if they don't know them already.



Our English learning has centred around the book *Leon and the Place Between*. We have learned how writers use lots of devices, such as noun phrases, adjectives and adverbials to describe imaginary settings.

In maths we have explored place value and used our knowledge of the relationship between hundreds, tens and ones to help us add and subtract 2 and 3 digit numbers.
