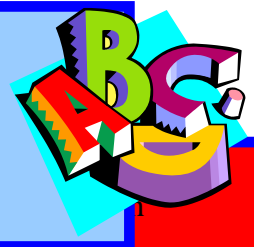

## Our Learning Journey

The class are settling in nicely to our routines and it is good to see many of them making positive progress. In phonics this week we have been focusing on **ur**, **ow** and **oi**. Our whole class reading involves looking for these sounds within a short sentence and children get the opportunity to segment and blend with their peers, for example "The **ow**l was feeling sad and **ow**n in **ow**n". Please help them develop this skill at home.

In maths, children have been talking a lot about more and less. We have been finding 1 one more than a given number or one less than a given number. We were using number tracks to help us and we are only staying within 10 at the moment.

In RE, we have performing little plays about the miracles Jesus performed during his life.



We have also been working scientifically in science by observing seasonal change and using magnifying glasses to inspect the different parts of a leaf.

## Focus on Learning

Our phonics this week will focus on trigraphs: ear, air and ure. These can be found in words like **near**, **chair** and **pure**. Again, have fun with your child writing words and making up silly sentences:

Look at the hair on the chair.  
There is a pure cure for sure.  
Put your ear near the rear of the bus dear.

It is great for children to hear, see, say and write as this embeds the skills of segmenting and blending further.

We are also learning to read and write tricky words. So far we have learned: I, the, to, he, she, said, was, no, go, you. This week we will look at: they.
