## Our Learning Journey



In English, the children designed their own MISSING! posters which have been displayed around the school by the children. This gives them an opportunity to explain to others what has happened and it is great to hear how the older children play along with the Year 1's imagination.

In handwriting, we are looking at the "fall family" of letters and practising them as often as possible. They include g, y, p, q and j.

In maths, we have been adding together and practising writing our number sentences in different ways. We have returned to the part-whole model to represent our calculations too.

The nativity story in RE has come to life with our Nativity Play this week as children have been rehearsing, writing captions, talking about the different characters and finally taking to the stage for a wonderful performance. Very impressed!

## Focus on Learning

Our phonics over the coming weeks will focus on consolidating what we already know. Children will continue practising their segmenting and blending skills and writing digraphs and trigraphs correctly.

Our handwriting practise will continue as often as possible as this complements their phonic sounds nicely and sets a good example of what is expected in terms of presentation and letter formation.
