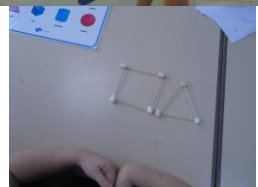

## Our Learning Journey

This week has flown by with plenty of sporting activities, art and handwriting. We have started rehearsing for our Nativity play in the Hall and children are beginning to learn their lines.



In maths, we have been looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We have used 3D shapes to print houses so children can recognise that the surfaces of 3D shapes have 2D shapes which are flat. We are using vocabulary such as sides, faces, cuboid, cube, square, pyramid.

We have been looking at the element of line in art and completed some scribble art. Children have had many opportunities to use wax crayons, chalk, felt tip and whiteboard pens to draw various creative lines: zigzag, horizontal, vertical, wavy, dotted, spirals and concentric circles. This vocabulary in art is important and links well with maths.

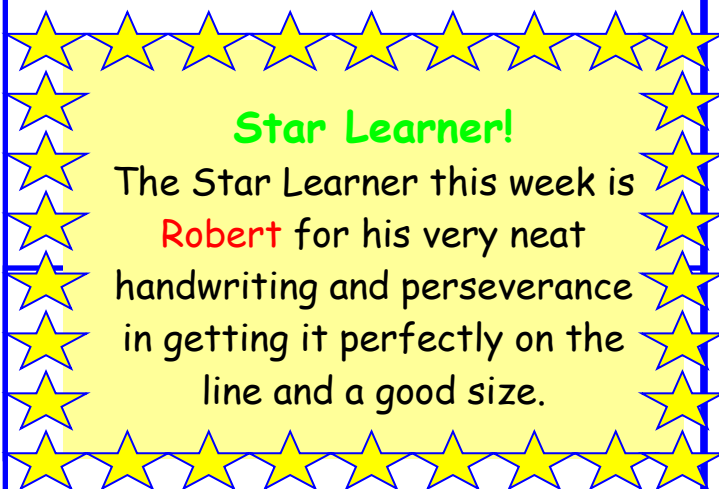
In English, we have learned about question marks and we have practised writing the punctuation mark correctly. We have spoken a lot about questioning words like: where, what, who, how, when, why.

## Focus on Learning

Our phonics over the coming weeks will focus on consolidating what we already know. Children will continue practising their segmenting and blending skills and writing digraphs and trigraphs correctly.

There will also be a big focus on handwriting over the next four weeks as children are rushing their handwriting skills and subsequently miss the guidelines. Correct letter formation is also the key to success at this point in Year 1.
