Wow what an exciting and busy term we have had in Cedar Class! The term has flown by and it's hard to believe we're nearly at the Christmas holidays.

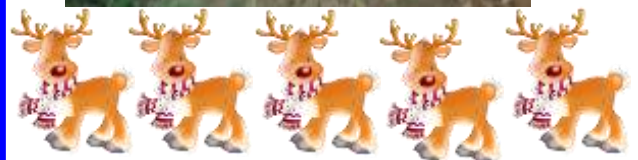
We have been working hard on our phonics, reading and maths learning and getting better all the time.
