School Places

If you have a child who was born between 01.09.17 and 31.08.18, the closing date for applications to Surrey for a place at Ongar is 15th January. Even if you already have a child in the school, you need to apply.

COVID 19 Testing

The rules are changing – again!

From Monday 17th January in England, those with a positive lateral flow test can test themselves again with the lateral flow test on the morning of the 5th day and the morning of the 6th day.

If both of those tests are negative they can then stop isolating immediately and return to school if they are well enough.

If a member of the household has COVID-19, the rest of the household does not need to isolate and children can attend school, although it is advised that they take a LFD Test every day.
