

## Music

Play music with increasing control  
Develop an understanding of musical composition  
Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts

Use and understand musical notation

This term we will be further developing our ukulele playing skills with Mrs Meyer. We continue to work with an opera teacher from Primary Robins.

## RE

Why is prayer important to Christians? How do people celebrate new life? How does Lent help Christians prepare for Easter?

Children will learn that there are different ways of praying. That Christians prepare for Easter in different ways.

## Art

Learn about great artists in history  
Develop techniques; drawing, painting  
Explore and produce creative work

The children will experience some of the main elements of Art (tone and colour) through the teaching of a variety of paint based skills lessons. They will learn about a variety of artists and about Mayan art/masks

## Year 4

## History

Develop a chronologically secure knowledge of world history. Develop the appropriate use of historical terms

The children will be discovering facts about the Mayan civilisation. They will think about how we know about the Mayan civilisation and will identify and use a range of evidence sources to help to understand more about the Mayan's way of life. We will be presenting learning in different ways.

## DT

Understand and use electrical systems in their products  
Generate, develop, model and communicate their ideas  
Evaluate their ideas and products against their own design criteria

Children will design, make and evaluate a hands free lamp that uses electricity to power the light. We hope to also use coding skills to create a computer controlled lamp with flashing eyes!

## Computing

Develop collaboration skills  
Evaluate digital content  
Evaluate and review own and other's work  
Use code in a new format to solve given problems and to debug  
Learn how to use the internet safely, respectfully and responsibly

This term we will continue to work with Mr Knott. We will begin the term by using a program called Audacity to create our own podcasts. After that we will use the Knowsley Scheme to create our own movie blockbuster about Dinosaurs. They will learn filming techniques and storytelling skills.

## Geography

Describe and understand key aspects of physical and human geography  
Use maps, atlases, globes including Ordnance Survey maps  
8 Point compass and coordinates

The children will identify, describe and explain how land use has changed over time in the local area.

We will use maths skills to link with map work and to compare and contrast climate graphs.

## Languages

Recall and pronounce a range of words accurately  
Use a variety of nouns and adjectives  
Children will develop their French vocabulary and learn how to build sentences linked to the classroom. This will include instructions and equipment. Children will also recap colours, body parts and family.

## PE

To link skills to make actions and sequences of movement  
To engage in collaborative physical activities  
Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance  
Perform dances using a range of movement patterns  
Vary and adapt skills

This term we will continue to work with Mrs Reed on Mondays and Miss Minto on Wednesdays. We will be developing our gymnastics skills as well as a bit of dance. In our Games session we will be playing Tag Rugby. when we will be developing, catching, throwing, particular techniques and how to play successfully in a team.
