



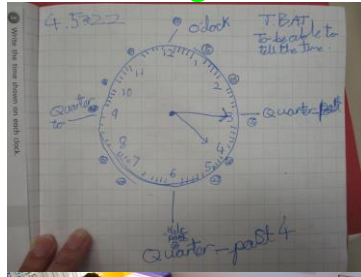
# YEAR 2 LEARNING LETTER

## Fabulous Learning



In maths this week we have started to look at telling the time in 5 minute intervals. Children have drawn their own clocks and plotted the numbers correctly. We have looked carefully at the hands and the minutes around the clock. Lots of vocabulary has been used: clockwise, minutes, hours, intervals, later, after, past and to. We have also revisited our fractions and have been doing many practical activities to find  $\frac{1}{2}$  of an amount or a  $\frac{1}{4}$  of an amount.

In PE we have been learning to throw a ball overarm and underarm to our partners. The children have built up good stamina for running and they are developing good teamworking skills as they are fielders who work together to prevent the strikers from scoring.

Primary Robins and swimming continue. We have had such lovely weather and the children have enjoyed getting out and getting active.

## Focus on Learning

We will continue to practise our counting and we will be doing many problem solving and reasoning activities. We will be counting objects, money and skip counting using numicon, cubes and coins.

Our theme this term is The Great Fire of London and there are many great activities planned for this fabulous topic. In science, we will be looking at different materials. In maths, we will begin to look at measuring mass, capacity and temperature. Our Jubilee Bulletin Board has also been installed and children will be finishing off some activities to contribute to this display. We are representing the number 70 in numerous ways.
