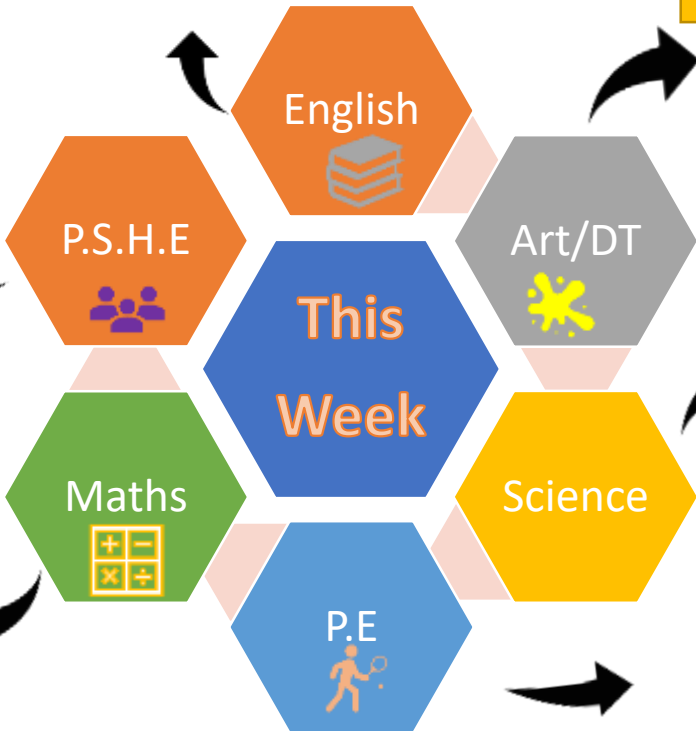
We returned to printing and have designed, cut and created our block tile ready for printing.
