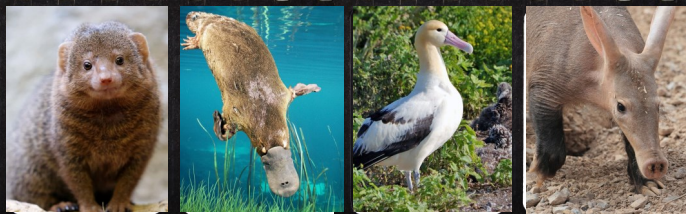
What a wonderful week Year 2 have had. We have had a busy time settling in and getting used to our new classroom routine.

Rowan Class have settled very well and have been very positive about their first few days.



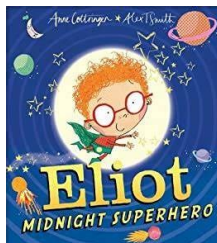
We have enjoyed a fantastic music lesson and all showed some excellent listening skills in our first PE session.
