Play

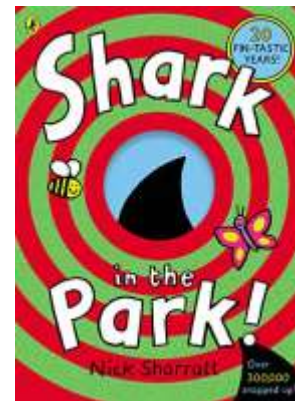
