

YEAR 5 LEARNING LETTER 23/9/22

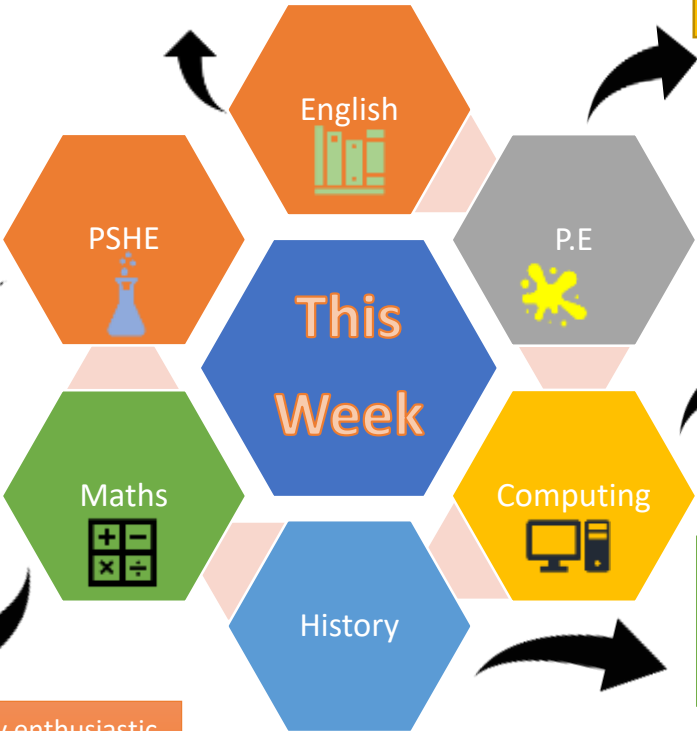
